## ABSTRACT

## The Administrative Problems of the Bangna Juvenile Training Centre

In this thesis the author pinpoints thoroughly problems which are exactly essential to the effectiveness of juvenile delinquents training. Without sound and effective training for delinquents, the training objective can hardly be fulfilled. In other words wrong treatment of individuals in the training centre will make the delinquents worse because they would develop poor attitude and imappropriate conduct. Besides the people who are released from the training centre would find themselves in difficulty in getting along with other people in society. They will of course, bring or cause problems to their parents, their families, society, and finally ultimately the nation as well. Reeducation and rehabilitation of juvenile deliquents are therefore the sole responsibility of the Bangna Juvenile Training Centre.

Additionally the author emphasizes administrative problems which are of great importance to the work of the Centre: organization, personnel, finance, vocational and general education training, release, follow-up, and coordination.

The assumption of this thesis is that "Since about ten years of its administration the Bangna Juvenile Training Centre has not yet met its goal due to some problems and difficulties." The author has, in this thesis systematically proved the hypothesis with many recommendations for further improvement and adjustment.

Finally, from the study and analysis of the administrative aspects of the Centre, proposals of new ideas in the training of juvenile delinquents and approaches applicable to problem-solving in this matter have been carefully prepared.
