

## SUMMARY

## STATISTICAL REPORT ON THAI CIVIL SERVANTS 1962

by *Pensri Vayavananda and Kattiya Amoradhat*

This statistical report is abstracted from a part of a research project, "The Income and Expenditures of Thai Civil Servants, 1961-1962", directed by Mrs. Pensri Vayavananda and Miss Kattiya Amoradhat and financed by the National Research Council through Thammasat University.

The purpose of this report is to gain some statistical insight into the Thai civil servant as he is at present and as he is likely to be in the near future. The statistical data was collected from official contacts government sources, essentially from departmental reports or from department payroll accounts presented to the Salaries Division, Comptroller General's Department, Ministry of Finance.

The scope of the data collection is limited to the five Civil Service grades (special, first, second, third and fourth) of the ordinary and teacher categories, which were the principal components of the Thai civil service. The period of collection is from April to June, 1962.

The four tables presented here are Table 1: Number of Civil Servants classified by Regional\* Changwads and Ministries pp. 493; Table 2: Number of Civil Servants classified by Region Changwads and grades pp. 497; Table 3: Number of Civil Servants classified by Ministries, Grades and office Locations pp. 502; Table 4: Number of Civil Servants classified by Ministries, Regions and Grades pp. 503.
